It would be beneficial to have your officer election anytime before DCON, so the new officers can attend their corresponding workshop. The workshops act as a type of training.

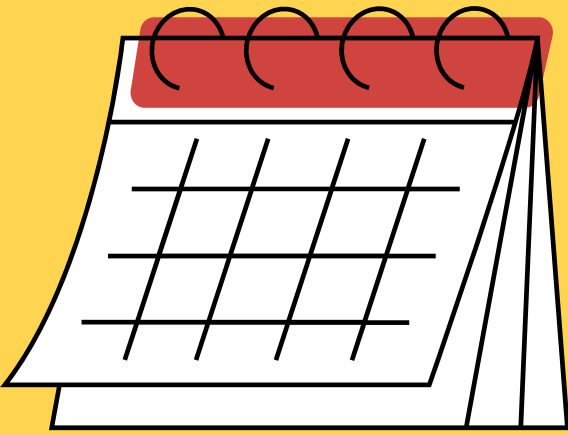

Spring Rally



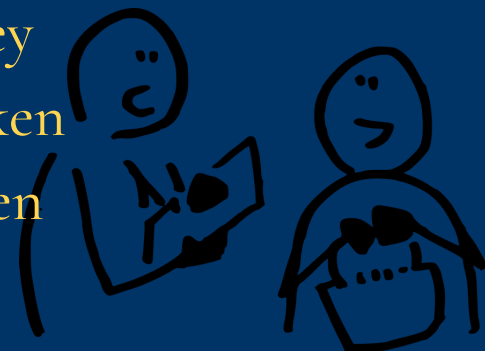
