# Club Contacts

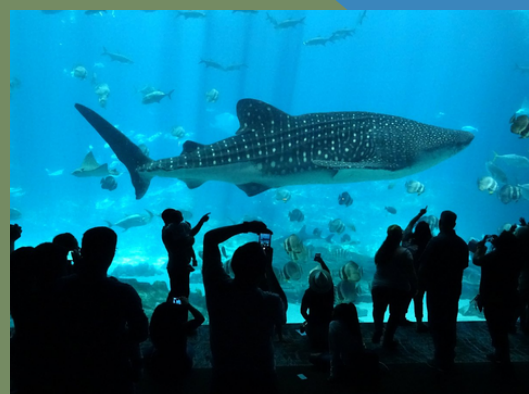
