Summer Board

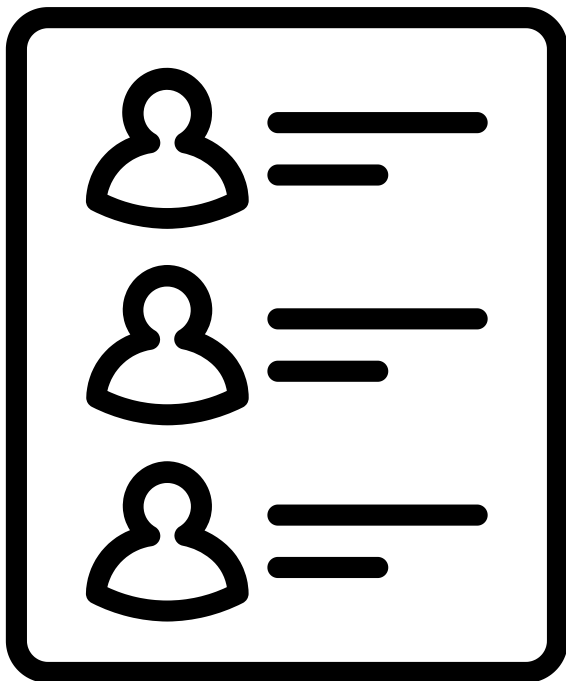
