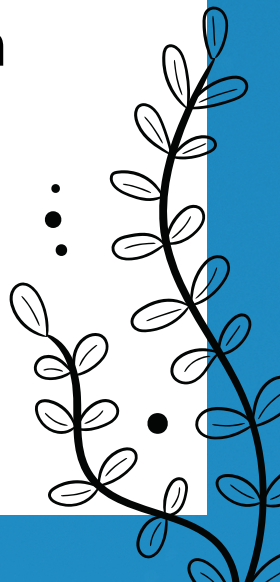
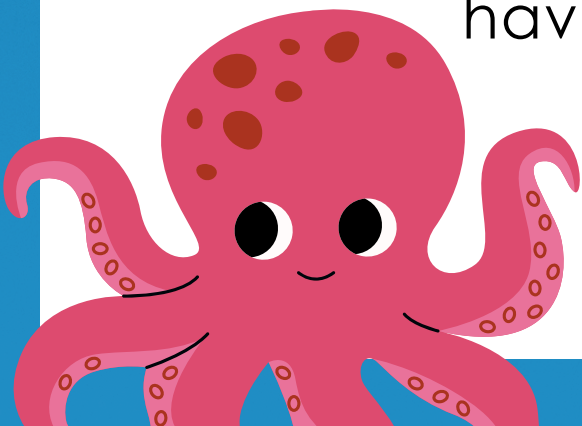


Club Contacts
