DUES UPDATE

At the International Convention, various amendments were passed at the House of Delegates. One of the more significant ones is about the dues. International dues have risen by \$3, so international dues are \$10 now. This also means the KT-district dues have risen \$3 to match international, so district dues are also now \$10. HOW TO PAY DUES

ATTENTION CLUB TREASURERS!

It is that time of year again where members need to pay dues. Clubs can **begin submitting their dues October 1, 2024**. Remember, existing members will still need to pay this year's dues as membership gets reset on October 1. Clubs who submit their dues before November 1, 2024 will be eligible for the Early Bird Award to be recognized at District Convention.

How to pay dues:

- 1. Collect dues from students along with their basic information (name, grade, etc)
 - a. Clubs may raise dues prices from the baseline \$20 to give the club more funding
 - b. Check with your school district on how to handle money
 - c. Do not handle money alone
- 2.Go to the membership update center (http://www.keyclub.org/MUC)
- 3. Click "dues and reports"
- 4. Click "membership update center"
- 5. Type in your username and password
 - a.Ensure that your advisor has updated officers' information on the MUC so that you can log in
- 6. Update advisors' and members' information
- 7. Once roster is up to date, click "Complete roster/Print invoice" to generate an invoice
- 8. Pay online or print the invoice and send it to Kiwanis International's P.O. Box
- 9. Keep using the MUC to add and remove members

MEMBERSHIP UPDATE CENTER

The Membership Update Center (MUC) is where secretaries, advisors, treasurers, and other club officers can update membership information and generate an invoice to pay dues. ACTION ITEMS!!

Here's what your clubs need to do by these dates:

- October 1st: Clubs can begin submitting dues.
- November 1st: Dues paid by this date are considered "Early Bird" and will be recognized and will also be sent a patch.
- December 1st: If dues have not been paid by this date, clubs enter a delinquent status. Delinquent clubs cannot have delegates or candidates at District or International Convention.
- February 1st: If dues remain unpaid by this date, clubs enter the suspended status.
- October 1st: If a club fails to pay dues after one year, it becomes inactive. To return to active status, the club must pay its dues AND a reactivation fee.
