What is LTG?

The Lieutenant Governor is a liaison between the District Board and the Divisional Key Clubs. They serve for 1 year and HAVE to be elected at a divisional spring rally in person. Those interested in pursuing this role will have to attend mandatory overnight board meetings throughout the year if elected. The LTG has to host an Officer Training and a Spring Rally. The LTG is responsible for ensuring that all of their clubs are operating smoothly and are kept up on the District level. They are the voice for their clubs. If you would like to run for this position you will need to contact me and review caucusing questions for your election. You will have to have a speech prepared and be ready to think on your feet at caucusing. If you have ANY questions or something is unclear, please please please reach out!

Spring Rally

The Division 7 Spring Rally will be held on February 22nd, 2025 at Liberty Bell MS from 1-3p.m. (Same place as Officer Training). Mark your calendars! Spring Rally is a place for the entirety of Division 7 to come together and elect next years LTG. (If your club is in good standing). Also, this is where the most outstanding Key Clubbers applicants will be interviewed by a panel of judges. If you are looking to run for International office or District office such as Governor you can seek endorsement at this Spring Rally from your Division. Spring Rally is open to all members of Key Club within Division 7. Each school will select two candidates to vote on behalf of their clubs. I would love to see an even greater turnout than what we had at officer training! If you are confused by any of the information that I've relayed thus far, please let me know! I want to encourage each club to try and nominate someone for LTG, this is a once in a lifetime opportunity and is well worth the election process!
