#### What is Spring Rally?

Spring rally is an annual division meeting where the incoming Lieutenant Governor (LTG) is elected.
Candidates give a 2 minute speech followed by 2 minutes of questioning, and 2 delegates from each attending school vote on the best candidate.

If you are interested in running for Lieutenant Governor (LTG), please reach out to me so I can help you be prepared for spring rally. You can run even if you are a freshman, or if it is your first year in Key Club, so don't be discouraged!

Spring rally is open to any Key Club members in the division, even if they are not voting or running for LTG. The meeting will also include a service project and information about upcoming district events. Keep an eye out for more info coming soon!

#### LTG Duties

#### What is an LTG?

A Lieutenant Governor (LTG) is a district officer who serves a division of the district.

The LTG of a division is elected at Spring Rally and officially installed at District Convention.

#### What does an LTG do?

LTGs essentially connect the clubs to the District. They are responsible for planning and hosting division events, such as Officer Training and Spring Rally, as well as contributing to district events, such as Fall Rally and District Convention
