Return to departure cities via Motorcoach

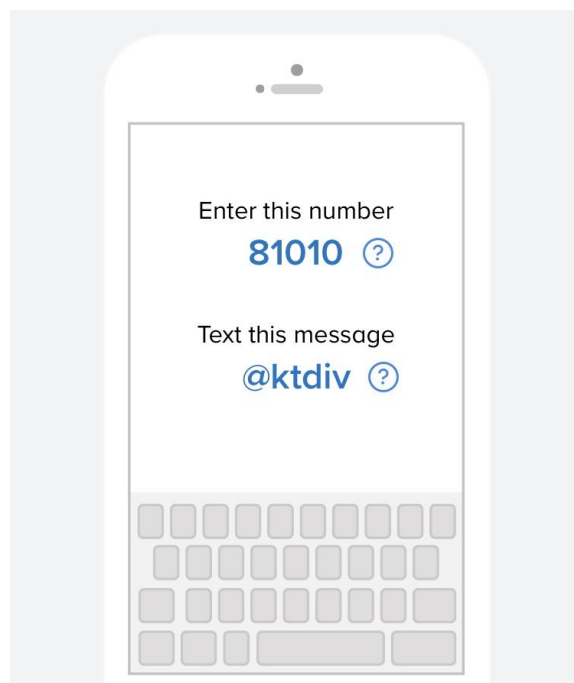
