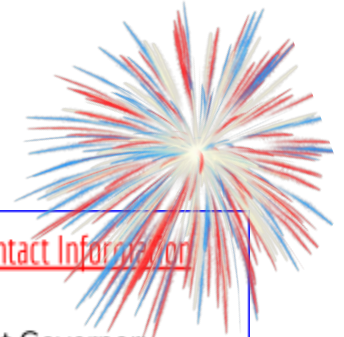
#### Dollywood Fall Rally
