The Ronald McDonald House is an organization to help create and find programs that improve the health and well-being of children and families. They provide groceries, cook meals, and provide a place to stay for families with hospitalized children. They do this in hope of families being able to focus on what really matters which is the health of their child. Some things you can donate to the RMHC are toys, canned foods, household items, and personal care items.

Ronald McDonald Houses are located near hospitals that provide specialized care for children and adolescents. Our house, located on 17th street right behind Cabell Huntington Hospital, offers families a home away from home, a refuge from the hospital.



Youth Opportunities Fund
