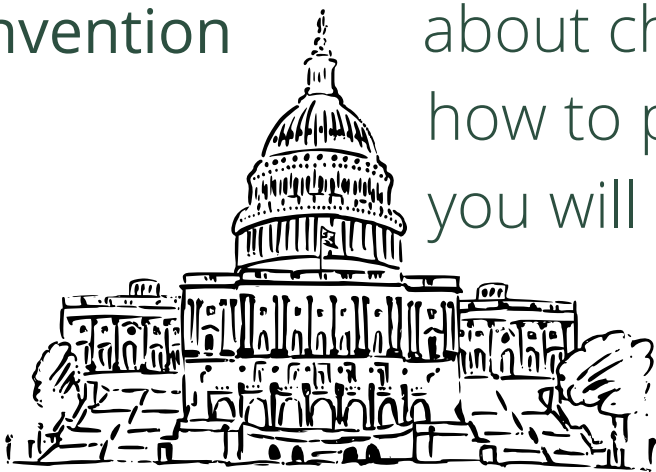

# **Elections:**

To run for Lieutenant Governor

**1.** Write a Declaration of Intent to me (include name, school, grade, and what position you are running for), the current LTG - If you want to know about what the LTG does, here is a file that goes through what responsibilities the LTG has:

**2.** Prepare a speech to give at Spring Rally (3 minutes) **3.** Prepare for a questioning session that will take place at Spring Rally (to view sample questions, please click this link:

Clubs are to send 2 delegates to vote for the new LTG. Each school's Key Club can have up to 2 delegates. YOU MUST BE PRESENT AT SPRING RALLY TO RUN FOR LTG!

If you are interested in running for treasurer or secretary you will run at the District Convention. To run for these positions you will have to create two caucusing speeches, each less than two minutes, as well as a speech for the House of Delegates, under five minutes for the governor and under three for the previous Treasure and Secretary. Towards the end there will be a longer caucusing session and an election will be held. If you would like to run for bulletin editor or historian you will apply after DCON and be interviewed by the governor and an adult.

Paper or styrofoam bowls, dish soap (dawn, etc), Paper plates, Kitchen sponges, Wool pads (cleaning metal bowls and wood), Quart size zip lock bags, Hotel size shampoo and conditioner, Squeezable applesauce, Goldfish, Individually packaged cookies and chips, Microwavable meals (mac and cheese, chef boyardee, etc), Tuna and cracker packs.

Then have a couple of people or one person drive the items to the Ronald McDonald House, after giving them a heads up you are coming. This is a great service project for you and your school to participate in!
